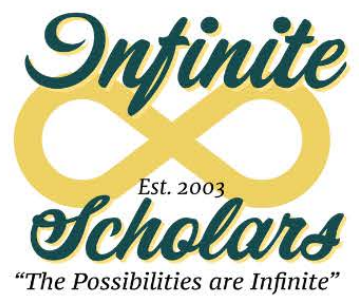

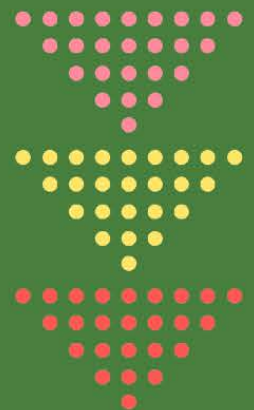

Meet Infinite Scholars Program's Founder/President/CEO



THOMAS "T" OUSLEY



Mr. Thomas "T" Ousley is a graduate of the University of Missouri with a degree in Linguistics and a certification in Education. Mr. Ousley also holds a master's degree from the University of Missouri Columbia in Reading and a master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Missouri-Saint Louis.

He retired from the Jennings School District in 2008 after dedicating 29 years of his life to educating high school students and serving as the Director of Attendance & Summer Work Programs.

In 2003, Mr. Ousley founded the Infinite Scholars Program which has become the largest diversity and inclusion college access providers in the nation. The Infinite Scholars Program has worked with more than 200,000 students and generated more than 2 billion dollars in scholarships offers. Also, a vast majority of the colleges and universities in our network waive application fees, out-of-state tuition fees and offer admission on site at our scholarship fairs that we host in various cities throughout the United States.

Mr. Ousley is a lifetime member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity and has fulfilled several state and regional positions in both Missouri and Illinois. He was a member of the I00 Black Men of America in Saint Louis, Missouri and Jacksonville, Florida. He was the Chairman of the Scholarship Committees for both states. He also holds honorary memberships in the Urban League of Chattanooga, Tennessee and Kansas City, Missouri and he has assisted them with enhancing their scholarship programs as well.

Mr. Ousley has received numerous prestigious awards from members of the United States Congress (2009-2015), the City of Detroit City Council (2014), the City of Flint, Michigan (2014), Sanford Florida Mayoral Office (2015), and Cook County, Illinois (2018). In 2007, Stillman College (located in Tuscaloosa, Alabama) recognized him by awarding a scholarship to students in honor of his mother.

In 2009, Mr. Ousley began working with the United States Army ROTC 7th Brigade Cadet Command and played an instrumental role in increasing their diversity and inclusion recruitment efforts which were geared toward minority students. 2009-2011 were considered the highest cadet recruitment years for the 7th Brigade. In April 2015, Mr. Ousley was awarded the Image & Humanitarian Award from the Hollywood and African Film Critics Association also known as the African Oscars. This was the same award that was first given to Nelson Mandela.

The Infinite Scholars Mentoring Programs, known as the Talented Tenth and College Scholars, have placed over eighty-five students in college all on scholarships. Three students from the Talented Tenth Program were able to leave high school early to participate in the early entry college for advanced students at Simon's Rock College in Massachusetts. There were over one hundred students in the Ferguson-Florissant School District that were members of the Talented Tenth Program.

Mr. Ousley is married and has one child.

WHEREAS, due to the efforts of Mr. Ousley and the team at Infinite Scholars, nearly 80% of participants in the Infinite Scholars program enroll in college. Infinite Scholars has now worked with more than 100,000 Scholars and has helped to facilitate more than one billion dollars in scholarships and financial aid; and

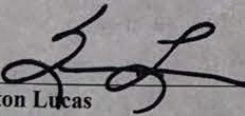

CPA Scholars Earn More Than \$2M In Scholarships At Infinite Scholars Fair

CPA Scholars impressed college recruiters with their preparation and professionalism. Confluence Preparatory Academy (CPA) Senior Scholars have reached an incredible milestone! At the Infinite Scholars Program Fair, 44 CPA students received a total of 135 college acceptances and were awarded an impressive \$2,084,632 in merit-based scholarships—the largest amount in CPA history. Many students were offered full-tuition and presidential scholarships on the spot, a testament to their hard work, preparation, and professionalism. The Infinite Scholars Program is known for providing life-changing opportunities by connecting high school students, particularly from underserved communities, with college admissions representatives. During the event, students not only gained college acceptances but also secured merit-based scholarships immediately, giving them a head start on their college journeys. CPA is incredibly proud of these scholars and their achievements. These opportunities are just the beginning, as students will have more chances to earn scholarships through upcoming college fairs, school-hosted career fairs, and college tours planned for the coming months.



Some schools offer on-the-spot acceptance and scholarship to local students

LANSING, Ill. (October 2, 2024) – More than 1,000 college acceptance letters and more than \$24 million in scholarships were offered to local high school seniors at a scholarship fair hosted at TF South High School in Lansing on Wednesday, Sept. 25.

The free event started at 10 a.m. with 55 representatives from not only colleges, but also career placement organizations, military branches, and the Lansing Police Department. The high school gym was packed with students from dozens of area high schools – including 16 schools that bussed students to the event. By the end of the day, approximately 1,100 students had participated in the fair.

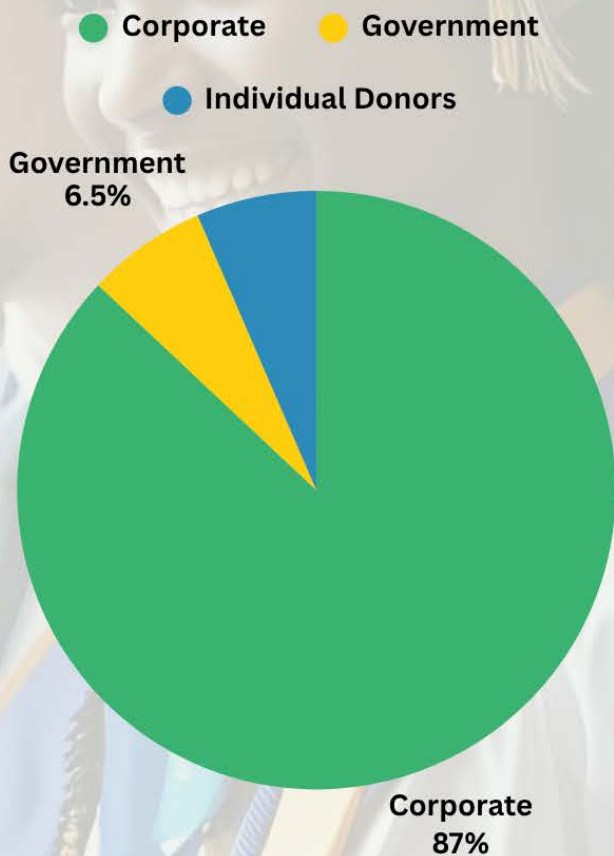

FY 24 FINANCIALS

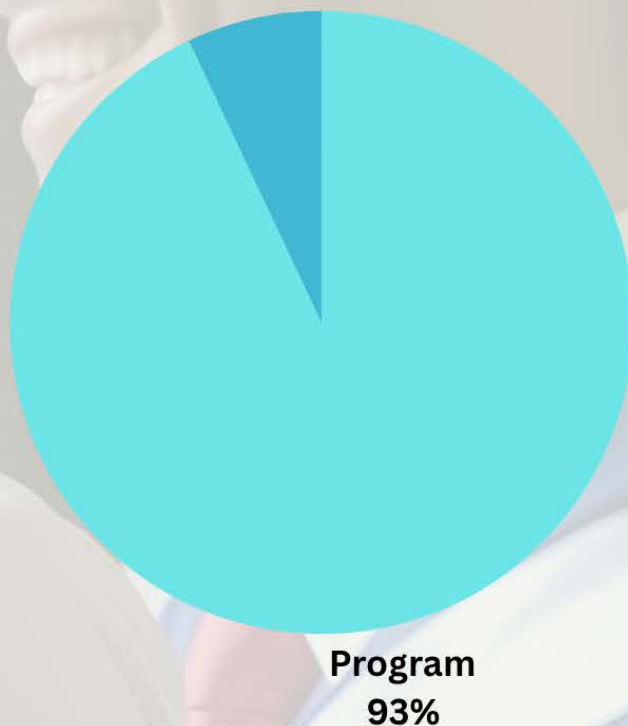
