




THOMAS "T" OUSLEY

Mr. Thomas "T" Ousley is a graduate of the University of Missouri with a degree in Linguistics and a certification in Education. Mr. Ousley also holds a master's degree from the University of Missouri Columbia in Reading and a master's degree in Educational Administration from the University of Missouri-Saint Louis.

He retired from the Jennings School District in 2008 after dedicating 29 years of his life to educating high school students and serving as the Director of Attendance & Summer Work Programs.

In 2003, Mr. Ousley founded the Infinite Scholars Program which has become the largest diversity and inclusion college access providers in the nation. The Infinite Scholars Program has worked with more than 200,000 students and generated more than 2 billion dollars in scholarships offers. Also, a vast majority of the colleges and universities in our network waive application fees, out-of-state tuition fees and offer admission on site at our scholarship fairs that we host in various cities throughout the United States.

Mr. Ousley is a lifetime member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity and has fulfilled several state and regional positions in both Missouri and Illinois. He was a member of the IOO Black Men of America in Saint Louis, Missouri and Jacksonville, Florida. He was the Chairman of the Scholarship Committees for both states. He also holds honorary memberships in the Urban League of Chattanooga, Tennessee and Kansas City, Missouri and he has assisted them with enhancing their scholarship programs as well.


Mr. Ousley has received numerous prestigious awards from members of the United States Congress (2009-2015), the City of Detroit City Council (2014), the City of Flint, Michigan (2014), Sanford Florida Mayoral Office (2015), and Cook County, Illinois (2018). In 2007, Stillman College (located in Tuscaloosa, Alabama) recognized him by awarding a scholarship to students in honor of his mother.

In 2009, Mr. Ousley began working with the United States Army ROTC 7th Brigade Cadet Command and played an instrumental role in increasing their diversity and inclusion recruitment efforts which were geared toward minority students. 2009-20II were considered the highest cadet recruitment years for the 7th Brigade. In April 20I5, Mr. Ousley was awarded the Image & Humanitarian Award from the Hollywood and African Film Critics Association also known as the African Oscars. This was the same award that was first given to Nelson Mandela.

The Infinite Scholars Mentoring Programs, known as the Talented Tenth and College Scholars, have placed over eighty-five students in college all on scholarships. Three students from the Talented Tenth Program were able to leave high school early to participate in the early entry college for advanced students at Simon's Rock College in Massachusetts. There were over one hundred students in the Ferguson-Florissant School District that were members of the Talented Tenth Program.

WHEREAS, Thomas "T" Ousley taught high school English and History for over thirty years in the Jennings School District in St. Louis, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, while teaching Mr. Ousley worked on many initiatives to assist low-income students to attend college and provide them with the mentoring and education needed for college acceptance and completion; and

WHEREAS, to ensure that low-income and first-generation students, deserving to go to college could receive the funding needed to attend college, in 2003 Mr. Ousley created "The Infinite Scholars Program", a non-profit organization, whose motto is "The Possibilities Are Infinite"; and

WHEREAS, due to the efforts of Mr. Ousley and the team at Infinite Scholars, nearly 80% of participants in the Infinite Scholars program enroll in college. Infinite Scholars has now worked with more than 100,000 Scholars and has helped to facilitate more than one billion dollars in scholarships and financial aid; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ousley understands that leadership is not about being in charge; leadership is about taking care of those in your charge; servant leadership is all about making the goals clear and then rolling your sleeves up and doing whatever it takes to help people win; and
